Rodden focuses not only on Orwell's work but also on his "saintly life," analyzing the impassioned responses of his admirers and enemies, including socialists, liberals, Marxists, feminists, anarchists, conservatives, neoconservatives, Zionists, and Catholics. No reader will emerge from this rigorous journey through the world of Orwell without having his or her own intellectual commitments challenged.
